**Unless noted in bracket play, losing team of prior match stays on court to work the following match. In some cases teams may work a different court than where you are playing. Please check schedule or with the site coordinator.*

FORMAT:

The schedule has the courts and times listed. The facilities will be open forty-five minutes before the first match. Please be prompt, as the tournament will start on time. After the first two rounds, the scheduled matches will start **immediately after the conclusion of the previous match**. Some divisions will have a venue change after the first pool is completed. If a team is moving facilities they are expected to be as timely as possible when changing. The tournament will run in a “**ASAP**” fashion, so if courts get ahead or behind we will start matches as soon as we can for all ages and venues. Please check the schedule and the site coordinator if you have any questions.

Regardless of power pools all teams can make the Gold Bracket.

Pool Play: For all 4-team pools this will be two sets to 25. For all 3-team pools this will be three sets to 25

Challenge Matches: All challenge matches will be 2 sets to 25 and are just for seeding in bracket play. There is no third set and if teams split we will go by points and then a coin flip. Challenge matches are not determining a team’s bracket but rather their seeding in the bracket.

Play Off Matches: All playoff matches are best 2 out of 3, with the deciding set played to 15 points.

18 and Under Divisions - 24 teams each – Pool A and Pool B are power pooled. The top teams in Pools AA, BB, CC and DD go to Gold, the second place teams go to silver, third go to bronze and fourth go to flight 1. The top two teams in pools EE and FF will play in flight 2 and the third and fourth teams in those pools play in flight 3.

17 and Under Divisions - 19 teams each –top four teams power pooled. The top two teams in Pools AA, BB and CC will play in Gold, the bottom two from those pools will play in Silver. All teams in pools DD and EE will play in Bronze.

This division that has 3-team pools that will play 3-sets to 25.

16 and Under Division – 28 teams – top 12 teams will be power pooled. The top two teams from pools AA, BB, CC, DD and EE will go to gold and the bottom two from those pools will go to silver. The top two teams from FF and GG will play in Bronze and the bottom two teams from those pools will play in Flight 1.

15 and Under Division – 20 teams – top 4 teams are power pooled. The top teams in Pools AA, BB, CC and DD will play in the Gold Bracket, the second place teams will play in Silver and the third place will play in Bronze. All teams in EE and FF will play in Flight 1.

14 and Under Division – 32 teams each – The top two teams in Pools AA, BB, CC and DD will play in Gold and the bottom two from those pools will play in Silver. The top two teams in Pools EE and FF will play in Bronze and the bottom two teams in those pools will play in Flight 1. The top two teams in Pools GG and HH will play in Flight 2 and the bottom two teams in those pools will play in Flight 3.

12 and Under Division – 15 teams – Pool A, B and C are traditional game play while pool D is triple ball. For playoffs, the top 6 girls teams will play in Gold, the bottom 5 will play in Silver. The 4 boys teams will be pulled out and participate in their own playoff bracket. All playoffs will be traditional game play and the Gold bracket will follow stricter serving rules.

AWARDS: First and Second place team in Gold Division, First in Silver Division
