



## **VFX Hocus Pocus – Facility Information and Rules:**

### **18s:**

- Gates – Chili High School (6 courts), 1 Spartan Way, Rochester, NY 14624
- Gates – Chili Middle School (1 court), 2 Spartan Way, Rochester, NY 14624
  - This location is only used for the second round of pool play.
- Edison Tech High School (2 courts), 655 Colfax St, Rochester, NY 14606

### **16s:**

- Main Street Armory (6 courts), 900 E. Main Street, Rochester, NY 14605
- East High School (3 courts), 1801 E. Main Street, Rochester, NY 14609
- Hot Shots Indoor Volleyball (1 court), 1046 University Ave, Rochester, NY 14607
  - This location is only used for Saturday's first round of pool play.

### **14s:**

- Pinnacle Athletic Campus (6 courts), 748 Phillips Rd, Victor, NY 14564

### **12s:**

- Wayne High School (3 courts), 6200 Ontario Center Rd, Ontario, NY 14520
- Wayne Middle School (2 courts), 6067 Ontario Center Rd, Ontario, NY 14519

*Same Campus: Buildings are about 200ft from each other*

**\*All locations will open at 7:00am both mornings for team's to arrive. \***

**Pinnacle Athletic Campus will have a spectator fee.** They will offer day and weekend passes. Please note that this is a facility charge that is coming from Pinnacle and not coming from VolleyFX. We apologize for this and ask that all participants understand it is not within our control.

Athletic Trainers are not supplied at each site. If you're athlete has a medical need please make arrangements to help her on your own. If there is an injury athletes will be encouraged to visit the nearest Urgent Care or Emergency Room.

### **Team Check In**

Friday night from 7:30pm – 9pm at Pinnacle Athletic Campus (main lobby when you enter)

All teams are encouraged to attend this check in.

Saturday morning, all teams that attended Friday night registration must do a quick check in with the registration table. If your team missed Friday night registration, you can hand in your roster and receive your team packet Saturday morning.

***Canadian Teams:*** At registration please hand in the USAV Foreign Team Form, Team Roster, Proof of Insurance and Proof of Registration with Ontario Volleyball.

### **Food Allowance / Concessions**

Please note that outside food is not allowed at **Main Street Armory and Pinnacle Athletic Campus.** Armory and Pinnacle will be selling concessions. **Players are allowed to bring small lunches containing healthy snacks that must remain in their bags.**

Any team that does not comply with the no food rule at these locations will **NOT** be allowed to participate in future VolleyFX events. By not following the rules the facilities lay out, our organization runs the risk of no longer being allowed to use the facility. The food restrictions will be strictly enforced.

First round of play for all teams – 2 minutes ball handling -4/4 hitting  
All rounds after 2 minutes ball handling -3/3 hitting

Two Lines people	One visible USAV member at the score table

**Note:** Visible Score and Libero Tracker can be the same person

\*Unless noted in bracket play, losing team of prior match stays on court to work the following match. You may work a different court than where you are playing. Please check schedule or with the site coordinator.

**FORMAT:**

The schedule has the courts and times listed. Please be prompt, as the tournament will start on time. After the first two rounds, the scheduled matches will start **immediately after the conclusion of the previous match**. Some divisions will have a venue change after the first pool is completed. If a team is moving facilities they are expected to be as timely as possible when changing. The tournament will run in a “ASAP” fashion, so if courts get ahead or behind we will start matches as soon as we can for all ages and venues. Please check the schedule and the site coordinator if you have any questions.

**All Divisions:** The pool play matches will be 2 sets to 25, and the playoff bracket matches will be a best 2 out of 3. Each non-deciding set will be to 25 with a minimum 2-point advantage (no scoring cap). Deciding set will be to fifteen points with a minimum 2-point advantage (no scoring cap).

**18 and Under Division** - 36 teams – the top 4 teams will be power pooled to begin the tournament into Pool A, the next 16 will be “power pooled” into Pools B, C, D and E. All teams in all pools will have an opportunity to play for Gold. Each team will be guaranteed 7 matches. The first place teams in Pools AA, BB, CC, DD, EE, FF and GG will play in the Gold bracket. The second place teams in those pools will play in the Silver bracket, the third place teams in those pools will play in the Bronze bracket, and the fourth place teams in them will play in the Flight One bracket. The first and second place teams in Pools HH and II will play in the Flight Two bracket. The third and fourth place teams in those pools will play in the Flight Three bracket.

**16 and Under Divisions** - 40 teams each – the top 16 teams will be power pooled to begin the tournament and all teams advance to a playoff bracket. Each team will be guaranteed 7 matches. The first place teams in Pools AA, BB, CC, DD, EE and FF will play in the Gold bracket. The second place teams in those pools will play in the Silver bracket, the third place teams in those pools will play in the Bronze bracket, and the fourth place teams in them will play in the Flight One bracket. The first and second place teams in Pools HH, II and JJ will play in the Flight Two bracket. The third and fourth place teams in those pools will play in the Flight Three bracket.

**14 and Under** – 24 teams – all teams advance to the playoffs. Each team will be guaranteed 7 matches. The first and second place teams in Pools AA, BB and CC will play in the Gold bracket. The third and fourth place teams in Pools those pools will play in the Silver bracket. The first and second place teams in Pools DD, EE and FF will play in the Bronze bracket. The third and fourth place teams in those pools will play in the Flight One bracket

**12 and Under** – 17 teams – all teams are guaranteed 6 sets in pool play and one play off match. The top six teams will be power pooled (Pools A and B), the next 3 teams will be in Pool C. The next 8 teams will be wrapped according to seeding in Pools D and E. All teams in Pools A, B and C will go to Gold. The top two teams out of Pools D and E will go to Gold. The bottom two teams in Pools D and E will play in Silver.

**AWARDS:** First and Second place team in Gold Division, First in Silver Division.
